The Association and the Gallery

Escondido Art Association is a 501 (c) (3) non-profit organization which was first founded on June 16, 1959 as Showcase of the Arts. Active until January 6, 1986, Showcase of the Arts was renamed Escondido Art Association. Now in its 51st year of continuous operation Escondido Art Association maintains a 170 person membership.

Artists Gallery, the display sector of Escondido Art Association was opened in June 1998. With its creation, members of the Escondido Art Association were provided with a permanent location from which to display and sell their art. Now approaching its ninth year at 121 West Grand Avenue in downtown Escondido, California, the gallery is up-and-coming. With a newly renovated showroom which regularly features new talents in the art community, the gallery is a wonderful resource for art lovers and collectors of all types.

Much to Offer

The gallery offers monthly shows, special feature exhibits, members only consignment program, and networking opportunities. Other opportunities include but are not limited to street fairs, Second Saturday, Cruising Grand, Tuesday afternoon Farmer's Market, and First Night celebration.
